## ATISN 24440- Complaint and Request for Internal Review

Thank you for your request for an internal review of the response you received to your recent request for information.

In undertaking my review I have considered both your initial request, the response that you received and the subsequent email sent by Rhian Pritchard on the 26 Feb. I have upheld the findings of the original response to your request, which is to say that I have determined we do not hold information relevant to your request.

Under section 512 of the Education Act 1996 local authorities are responsible for providing food in schools to registered pupils in maintained schools. Local authorities are therefore responsible for this provision and have discretion on which suppliers/contractors are used in the execution of their duty. The Welsh Government does not therefore hold any information on which suppliers are used by individual local authorities.

I understand that you may be dissatisfied with this determination.
