Our response

I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

Decisions on investment strategies and specific investments are a matter for the Wales Pension Partnership and its constituent pension authorities. As a result, we hold no papers on those sorts of decisions and would not have the right to see them. Therefore, I can confirm that we do not (and would not) hold any record of any documentation between Wales Pension Partnership and BlackRock.
