- 1. Any service operated by or on the Microsoft Azure cloud platform by any of your processors or contracted service providers (including a direct contract with Microsoft)
- 2. Any Microsoft M365 service

Our response

The information requested is exempt under Section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act (2000) information reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means. Welsh Government have not received any specific information or documentation relating to Microsoft's processing of data within countries that is not already published publicly on Microsoft's website.

Welsh Government use UK based Azure services wherever possible (followed by EU and the US in preference order for any Microsoft global services that are not available within the UK region) and our M365 services are based on the UK geography, again details of which are already published by Microsoft.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
