ATISN 24629 – The Kaleidoscope Project

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 03 April 2025 relating to the Kaleidoscope Project. You have requested the following:

1. *A copy of the letter sent to Welsh Government from Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (CAV), highlighting concerns in relation to The Kaleidoscope Project's (TKP) clinical involvement in Dyfodol not being registered as an independent clinic with HIW*
2. *Any subsequent related correspondence between CAV, HIW, TKP and Welsh Government in relation to the matter of TKP's requirements to register any of its clinics as independent medical clinics with HIW*

Our Response

Having carried out a search for a letter and subsequent correspondence that matches your request I can confirm that we have been unable to locate any documents that are within the scope of your request.

The Welsh Government are aware that in April and May 2024, Health Inspectorate Wales (HIW) sent you all documents held in relation to the Kaleidoscope Project's requirement to register with them.
