THE TRUNK ROAD (A5) (CHIRK BY-PASS, HALTON CLWYD)
(DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1992

COMING INTO FORCE

31st January 1992

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 82(2), 83(1) and 124 of, and Paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the North Wales Police hereby Orders and directs as follows:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 31st January 1992 and may be cited as the Trunk Road (A5) (Chirk By-Pass, Halton, Clwyd) (De-Restriction) Order 1992.
2. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Act of 1984.
3. The Trunk Road (A5) (Chirk By-Pass, Clwyd) (De-Restriction) Order 1991(b) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

Those lengths of the London - Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) at Halton in the County of Clwyd which extend from:-

- i. the centre point of the Whitehurst Roundabout in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 118 metres;
- ii. the centre point of the Whitehurst Roundabout in a generally westerly direction to the centre point of the (A5) Whitehurst Gardens Roundabout for a distance of 1.06 kilometres.
- iii. the centre point of the (A5) Whitehurst Gardens Roundabout in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of 676 metres.
