- 3. The <u>Local Government Revenue and Capital Settlement</u> is published on an annual basis and contains the letter to local authorities, the Final Local Government Finance Report 2024-25 and the Final local government revenue and capital settlement tables which include:
 - Change in Aggregate External Finance (AEF), adjusted for transfers, by Unitary Authority
 - Change in AEF plus floor funding, un-adjusted for transfers, by Unitary Authority
 - AEF per Capita, by Unitary Authority
 - Breakdown of General Capital Funding (GCF), by Unitary Authority
 - Local Authority Capital Settlement, by Ministerial Portfolio
 - Components of Capital Financing Standard Spending Assessment (SSA), by Unitary Authority
 - New Responsibilities, by Unitary Authority
 - Comparison of total SSA, by Unitary Authority
 - SSA Sector totals, adjusted for transfers, by Unitary Authority for previous year
 - SSA Sector totals, by Unitary Authority
 - Service Indicator Based Assessments (IBAs), by Unitary Authority
 - Details of principal council funding, by Unitary Authority
 - Adjustments to AEF base, by Unitary Authority
 - List and estimated amounts of Grants for total Wales.
 - Components of change, isolating the impact of updating individual elements of the formula with the latest data

4. The <u>Background information for standard spending assessments</u> is published as a report with two excel workbooks presenting information on the Service IBAs and the associated indicators. Together this is known as the Green Book.


- 5. Detailed information on Settlement outputs (from 1996-97 to current year)
