The following funding has been paid to the OEAP to support the FE sector to effectively plan and deliver educational visits:

Welsh Government	2021-22 (financial year)	£5,000
	2022-23 (financial year)	£25,000
	2023-24 (financial year)	£15,000
Medr	2024/25 (academic year)	£10,000*

<sup>\*</sup>Full 2024/25 (academic year) allocation is £20,000

The purpose of the funding was to develop training and guidance for FE institutions to assist with the planning and management of educational visits, including:

- Co-ordinating a steering group for FE institutions.
- Reviewing and updating OEAP guidance to reflect the specific context of the FE sector.
- Piloting and delivering FE visit co-ordinator training.
- Piloting and delivering senior leader training on the supervision and oversight of educational visits.
- Piloting and delivering management of visit emergencies (MoVE) training
- Working with the FE sector to develop e-learning modules for staff involved in planning and leading educational visits.

The Welsh Government funding was issued under the standard WG grant terms and conditions. Information on funding from 2024/25 onwards is held by Medr, the Commission for Tertiary Education and Research.
