# Eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM) data within the settlement

# **Summary**

- 1. This paper provides analysis of the eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM) pupil numbers taken from the <u>January 2024 Pupil Level Annual School Census (PLASC)</u>.
- This paper summarises our options for eFSM data for the 2025-26 settlement following on from decisions to use a 3-year average (2021, 2022 and 2023) of those pupils recorded as eFSM or Transitionally Protected (TP) for the 2024-25 settlement

3. DSG members are asked to consider the analysis and options discussed throughout the paper and agree on an option for use in the 2025-26 settlement.

## **Background**

11. Eligibility for Free School Meals (eFSM) is used as a proxy of deprivation in the assessment of relative need to spend on teaching and other services in the local government settlement but is not used as a proxy for the need to spend on school meals. More information on the background can be found in papers from previous years.

## **Options**

- 12. The analysis summarises 3 options:
  - a) Option 1: Use the latest data 2024 PLASC data. Pupils recorded as eFSM or TP.

- b) Option 2: Use the latest 3 year average (2022, 2023 and 2024) of the PLASC data. Pupils recorded as eFSM or TP. The advantage of using an average of the dataset is that it smooths out volatility.
- c) Option 3: Use the latest 4 year average (2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024) of the PLASC data. Pupils recorded as eFSM or TP. The advantage of using an average of the dataset is that it smooths out volatility.

## **Analysis**

#### <u>Data</u>

- 13. Table 1 in Annex A shows the number and share of pupils in primary school eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM) or those recorded as transitionally protected (TP) by local authority.
- 14. **Table 2** in **Annex A** shows the number and share of pupils in **secondary school** eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM) or those recorded as transitionally protected (TP) by local authority.
- 15. **Table 3** shows an exemplification of each of the options. **Further analysis is** summarised in the attached spreadsheet.

#### Conclusion:

- 16. The exemplifications are based on the isolated effect of the FSM data on the 2024-25 Settlement. FSM data on EOTAS pupils are **not included** in the analysis. Other than the change to the FSM data, the exemplifications do not account for any other changes in data that will be made for the 2025-26 Settlement, or the impact of transfers in and out.
- 17. DSG members are asked to consider and discuss the analysis included in this paper and agree on an option for the FSM data for the 2025-26 settlement.
