ATISN 24706 – PEMBROKESHIRE COAST NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY’S PROPOSED ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION WITHDRAWING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS FOR CAMPING AND CARAVANS

I refer to your request. You asked for:

- *Any correspondence, either in written or electronic form, between officials at Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority and officials or Ministers at the Welsh Government, on plans by PCNPA to introduce an Article 4(1) Direction to control temporary camping and caravan sites within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority. This will remove permitted development rights for 28-day camping, caravan and mobile home sites within the National Park. I would like to see correspondence that you have between 1 January 2023 until 11/5/2025.*
