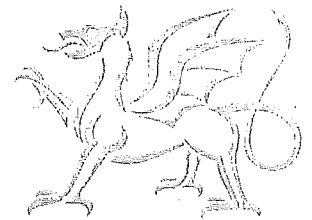

**CONFIRMATION OF MATCH FUNDING FROM PATHWAY TO PROSPERITY MATCH FUNDING
POT**

Following WEFO's letter of 22 June 2006 giving approval for the above project, I am writing to confirm that match funding will be made available for the project from the Pathway to Prosperity match funding pot. This grant is given under S126 of the Housing Grants Construction and Regeneration Act 1996 and is based on the details provided in the Structural Funds application form sent to us. If the information contained in this form changes or is inaccurate then we reserve the right to reconsider this confirmation.

An expected breakdown of expenditure on the project as shown in the WEFO approval letter is:

The amount of match funding we will make available therefore is a maximum of £1,234,551, which represents 39.834% of the overall eligible project expenditure. We will

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liaise with WEFO about the phasing and timing of payments and will adopt the same approach as them to providing funds in advance.

The claim forms that you send to WEFO on a quarterly basis will be copied to us by WEFO. This will save the need for any additional separate claim form for the match funding. We will use these forms to establish eligible spend on the project and will assume that 39.834% of the eligible expenditure is from the Pathway to Prosperity Match Funding Pot. This is in line with the proportion of the total eligible project expenditure that is from the match funding pot. Payments, including any advance payments, will be made in line with arrangements for funding agreed with WEFO.

In accepting the offer from WEFO you will be bound by the terms and conditions attached to that funding. If for any reason, WEFO should withhold payment of grant or reclaim grant already paid, we reserve the right to take similar action.

Also, this grant of match funding is being made on the understanding that such funding does not distort competition and is therefore not a State Aid. If you engage in any activity that affects this, we reserve the right to withhold any further payment of grant and to reclaim any grant already paid.

It is a condition of accepting this offer of match funding that you must agree to make any necessary repayment within a period of 30 days from the date of the invoice.

To affect close liaison with WEFO over payments for, and the monitoring of, this project, we need your agreement that WEFO can share with us all information that you supply to them. If you are content with this and the arrangements outlined above, please sign and return the attached copy of this letter for our records. I would also be grateful if you could complete and return the enclosed PL8 form, to facilitate payment direct into your Bank account.
