Request for Information - ATISN 24852

Further to my letter of 20 June advising we did not hold the information you were requesting – namely the total number of Road Traffic Collision Stats reports received by the Vale of Glamorgan Council, in relation to the traffic island at the junction to Cog Moors treatment works on Barry Road, Dinas Powys - my colleagues in our Statistical Branch have advised me it is possible for you to see the information online as it is in the public domain. The information was first published last month.

I attach the link to our Welsh Government website where you can locate the information you are seeking.

To navigate and interrogate the website I suggest the following:

Once you are on the map page - from the top six boxes choose COLLISION MAPS

In the 8 boxes below ensure they are all set to ALL (make sure none of the drop down boxes are “ticked” and they are all blank) – although for ease I would suggest choosing Vale of Glamorgan in the Local Authority box otherwise you will receive all the data for all of Wales.

Once the data has loaded you can then scroll in and see the collisions for the last 7 years on the junction you were looking for information for – to see what year any particular collision happened go to the year box and tick the year (ensure the Quarter Box is still set to All) and then that will bring up the collisions – if nothing is showing then it will mean there were no collisions there for that year.

The dot colours of the collisions signify the severity of the incident:

Blue dot – slight

Orange dot – severe

Red dot - fatal
