Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod traffig ar gyfer y darn perthnasol o gefnffordd yr A40, wedi eu bodloni y dylid gwahardd traffig ar ddarn penodedig o'r gefnffordd oherwydd gwaith y bwriedir ei wneud ar y ffordd neu gerllaw iddi.

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, felly, drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir iddynt gan adran 14(1) a (4) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(1), yn gwneud y Gorchymyn hwn.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A40 (Pontargothi, Sir Gaerfyrddin) (Gwahardd Cerbydau Dros Dro) 2025 a daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 25 Mehefin 2025.

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (Pontargothi, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2025 and this Order comes into force on 25 June 2025.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 25 June 2025 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road bridge over the Afon Cothi that extends from the driveway entrance of Neuadd Cothi House to the junction of River Cothi Road in Pontargothi.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
