ATISN 24842 – Baroness Casey's audit of group-based child sexual exploitation

Thank you for your request to Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 19 June 2025 relating to the Baroness Casey's audit.

You requested the following:

• Information on why the Welsh government did not supply data for the report.

Our Response

Welsh Government does not hold the information requested.

Baroness Casey published her audit report on group-based sexual exploitation of children on 16th June.

On page 52, the report states, "We also sought data from the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC) and the Government of Wales on how many cases of child sexual abuse or exploitation they see in health services but have only been able to obtain data from Sexual Assault Referral Centres (England)." This was incorrect as health data had not been requested by the audit team from Welsh Government. This was raised with the audit team.

On 20th June, Baroness Casey wrote to the First Minister to apologise for the error, confirming that how many cases of child sexual abuse of exploitation seen in health was not requested from Welsh Government by the audit team and providing assurance that the report would be amended. We have received confirmation that the report has now been amended.

Next Steps
