Information requested

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 23 June 2025. You have requested the following regarding the Pride Funding:

1. The total amount of public money spent by the Welsh Government on Pride events in each financial year from 2018/19 to the most recent year available.
2. A breakdown of this funding by event or organisation (e.g. Pride Cymru, Newport Pride, Cowbridge Pride, etc.).
3. Details of any specific funds, schemes, or grant programmes (such as the Wales-wide Pride Fund) used to support these events, including total annual budgets for each scheme.
4. Any additional funding or in-kind support (such as promotional materials, staffing, or logistics) provided to Pride events during the requested period.
