

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A5 (MAN I'R
GOGLEDD O FETHESDA, GWYNEDD) (DILEU
CYFYNGIAD) 2025**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn drwy arfer eu pwerau o dan adrannau 82(2) ac 83(1) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, a ddaw i rym ar 30 Mehefin 2025.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw adfer y terfyn cyflymder cenedlaethol ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A5 sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 135 o fetrau i'r gorllewin o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Thal Gae hyd at bwynt 19 o fetrau i'r dwyrain o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Thyddyn Iolyn, i'r gogledd o Fethesda, Gwynedd.

**THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (NORTH OF
BETHESDA, GWYNEDD) (DERESTRICTION)
ORDER 2025**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order in exercise of their powers under sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 30 June 2025.

The effect of the Order is to derestrict to the national speed limit the length of the A5 trunk road that extends from a point 135 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Tal Gae to a point 19 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Tyddyn Iolyn, north of Bethesda, Gwynedd.

During a period of 6 weeks from 27 June 2025, a copy of the Order and plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal opening hours at Bangor Library, Gwynedd Road, Bangor LL57 1DT. These documents can also be viewed on the Welsh Government's website at <https://gov.wales/road-orders>.
