Agenda items and key points discussed:

- 3) AC6 update (onshoring an interconnector from Scotland)
- National Grid are looking at Wales strategically, as well as the rest of the network, considering major reinforcement projects for Net Zero
- Currently looking at strategic options for bringing on to shore an offshore HVDC link between Scotland and Wales. This is a similar technology to interconnectors.
- National Grid have been asked to do detailed scoping work and submit business plan to Ofgem.
- Possible landing points have been reviewed for environmental measures etc. and N Wales is currently being explored as the potential onshoring point.
- Work considering any routing corridors for instance, not yet commenced, so very early stages of project
- The resulting strategic options appraisal report will be a public document later.
- It is challenging to pinpoint a timeframe for the project as it is in the early stages.
- o The strategic options analysis will go to Ofgem in the new year who will assess it.
- o This may be followed by a competitive tendering process to who takes forward the project.
- o Supply chains have to be procured.
- o An educated estimate of project arrival would be mid 2030s but nothing more specific is determinable at this stage.

• There is potential for Welsh businesses to be in the supply chain for project delivery – although National Grid may not deliver this project.
