## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 30 July 2025. You asked for: Copies of any emails, letters or other documents where Welsh Government have advised and / or informed Caerphilly council that they specifically need to make a change to waste management collections so that residual waste is collected 3 weekly in the future.

## Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

However, the Welsh Government publishes a blueprint which outlines the recommended Local Authority approach to collecting waste and resources for preparing for reuse, recycling and other treatments.
