Thanks Redacted s40(2),

Have also had discussion with Redacted s40(2) just now and with colleagues from IPC cell. Will discuss further at Cell meeting 1200.

My sense is that this relates to the planned publication of the NIPCM in England and the focus on "transmission based precautions" section which states that droplet precautions required for SARS CoV-2.

I am comfortable with this on the basis that this is the correct level of protection unless other measures of the hierarchy of controls cannot be implemented in full when FFP3 masks are indicated. FFP3 also indicated for AGPs.

Transmission Based Precautions section of NIPCM may also be reviewed soon looking at more of a "spectrum" of transmission – droplet / short range aerosol and long range aerosol – in line with WHO guidance and no change to PPE requirements.

Will advise further as I receive any new information.
