- 3. Figures for improvement notices issued, licences suspended or revoked, and complaints received relating to dog breeding.
- 4. Number of investigations into suspected illegal or unlicensed dog breeding.
- 5. Any available data on prosecutions related to puppy farming or illegal breeding.
