These titles are protected by the Engineering Council's Royal Charter and may only be used by registrants. There are estimated to be some 350,000 staff working in the operational delivery profession across government.  Within the Welsh Government, the profession covers a wide variety of roles including those delivering services direct to citizens and those working in corporate functions.
