Information requested

- 1. The total amount of financial support provided by the Welsh Government to West Wales Airport since it was first opened.
- 2. The total amount of outstanding money owed by West Wales Airport to the Welsh Government.
- 3. The total number of flights made by Hermes 900 and Hermes 450 drones from West Wales Airport since it was first opened.
- 4. Any existing contracts held by Elbit Systems with West Wales Airport, Parc Aberporth and MOD Aberporth.
- 5. Memoranda of Understanding between the Welsh Government and the MOD on the use of West Wales Airport, Parc Aberporth and MOD Aberporth.
- All correspondence between the Welsh Government and the UK
 Government on the use of West Wales Airport, Parc Aberporth and MOD
 Aberporth for testing unarmed drones subsequently deployed in the war
 in Gaza.

Our response

For questions 1 and 2, we can confirm that the Welsh Government has not provided any direct financial assistance to WWA.

WWA currently lease some buildings from us at Parc Aberporth but they are up to date with their rental payments and therefore do not owe us any money on these buildings.

For the remaining questions, having searched our records we can confirm that we do not hold the information as requested.
