Thank you for your request for information of 27 August. You asked for the following information:

The number of visits made by the Cabinet Secretary for Transport and North Wales to Llannerch Bridge in Denbighshire since take up his role in March 2024.

### **Our Response**

The Cabinet Secretary for Transport and North Wales has visited Llannerch Bridge twice since March 2024, in a personal capacity, rather than a scheduled Ministerial visit. One visit was in December 2024 and the other in March 2025 when he visited the St Asaph Tweed Mill.
