Thank you for your request for information of 15 September. You asked for the following information in relation to cameras set up in Rhayader.

- 1. What is the purpose of these cameras? The information given says that it is to measure pedestrian traffic, but for what purpose?
- 2. Who will this data be shared with?
- 3. Are the cameras facial recognition cameras?

Our Response

- 1. The cameras are to monitor pedestrian movements for a potential scheme on the A470 in Rhayader.
- 2. The data but no actual footage from the cameras will be shared with Powys County Council as they are the designer of the scheme for Welsh Government.
- 3. The cameras are not facial recognition cameras. The resolution is very low which just allows for the classification of the type of highway user e.g person, car. Once the survey is complete all data is destroyed after 30 days.
