Thank you for making yourself available for the scheduling inspection of the cup-marked stone on your land yesterday. I was asked by [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data] to visit and undertake the scheduling assessment and I did not realise until my visit that the monument lay on a field boundary that also represented the property boundary between two land holdings. Please accept my apologies for not realising this and for contacting you at very short notice.

This monument does not appear in any of the formal archaeological records for the area and is an exciting discovery. Having inspected the monument and discussed it with [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data], I am of the opinion that it meets Cadw's non-statutory scheduling criteria for designation. As such, I intend to propose it for legal protection as a scheduled monument of national importance. You will hear from my colleagues in our designation team in due course and the monument will benefit from interim protection once the public consultation on our proposal to designate commences. Please note that scheduling status does not confer any right of public access nor does it change the ownership of the monument. The scheduling status will be recorded on the Land Registry. You have looked after the monument and it is in good condition. I do not anticipate that the proposed scheduling would affect your current land management of the monument or the land immediately around it. Please be aware that scheduling affords legal status to the scheduled area and you will need to follow Cadw's Scheduled Monument Consent (SMC) process for some types of work within the scheduled area. Some works may also be eligible for financial contribution through Cadw's Ancient Monument Grant scheme. Cadw's regional Field Monument Warden, [Redacted – Regulation 13 Personal Data], and myself are available to provide advice relating to the SMC and grant procedures and monument management, as required.
