Thank you for contacting Cadw in relation to the bridge at Llandbedr.

Pont Llanbedr is a Listed structure and is also a scheduled monument (ME206), which means that the bridge is legally protected from damage or disturbance under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act, 1979 (as amended by the Historic Environment (Wales) Act 2016). Therefore, any works that could alter the appearance of the bridge or impact on the structure would require scheduled monument consent (SMC) from Cadw prior to those works being undertaken.

As a guide, any proposals that impact upon the bridge itself are unlikely to be granted consent due to the damaging physical impact this would have on the structure. Any proposals will also need to consider the setting and visibility of the bridge. Therefore, if the footbridge were to be located on or away from the bridge, consideration will need to be given to how the footbridge would impact upon the setting of the monument.

It would be useful if you could share with us any outline proposals that you may have developed or drawn up so that we can give you some initial comments to help direct your approach.
