- Cadw officials have provided specialist advice to inform the listed building consent application, which has been submitted and is to be determined by the local authority.
- It is not the role of Cadw officials to approve any emergency works that may become necessary, but they have provided advice to ensure that whatever is done, if anything, is properly justified and kept to the absolute minimum as set out in legislation.
- It is inappropriate for me to comment on the merits of any works that may be necessary as I must not prejudice the statutory consent process.
- The Welsh Government's Planning Directorate is currently considering the requests for the application for listed building consent to be called in for determination by the Welsh Ministers.
