ADVICE

Background

- 1. Established by Welsh Government in 2023, the Ynni Cymru programme’s aim is to ensure that energy generation benefits are retained locally, promoting community ownership of integrated renewable energy assets as a central strategy in the transition to a low-carbon economy.
- 2. The core focus for Ynni Cymru was agreed to be the development and delivery of Smart Local Energy Systems (SLES).
- 3. A smart local energy system is a way to bring together different energy assets in a local area and operate them in a ‘smarter’ way, which could be more productive or more integrated, whilst seeking to maximise benefits to both local communities and the local energy network.
