Thank you for your request which I received on 14 November 2025. You asked for:

- 1. The number of private companies in Wales authorised to use facial recognition computer software to harvest human biometric data, and
- 2. The primary and / or secondary legislation available to Welsh Government to monitor and control the harvesting and use of human biometric data by private companies in Wales.

## Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government. Facial Recognition Technology is a reserved matter and is the responsibility of the UK Government.
