### Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 24 November 2025. You asked for:

- 1) All recorded information pertaining to communications between the Welsh Government and:
  - a) The Most Reverend George Stack (Archbishop of Cardiff)
  - b) The Most Reverend Mark O'Toole (Archbishop of Cardiff and Menevia)
  - c) The Right Reverend Peter Brignall (Bishop of Wrexham)
- 2) During their tenures (time in office)
- 3) Between the dates of 1 January 2020 to 1 January 2023
- 4) To only include communications which discuss:
  - a) The pastoral care of the dying elderly, dying disabled, and dying NHS nursing personnel during the pandemic.
  - b) Discussions and decisions concerning the closure or opening of Catholic churches.

# Our response

The information you requested is enclosed:

The Welsh Government holds no recorded information other than what is publicly available in the published minutes of the **Faith Communities Forum** meetings.

Within the requested timeframe, the following is relevant:

- The Most Reverend George Stack (Archbishop of Cardiff) attended the Faith Communities Forum on 3 June 2020 and is noted as sending apologies on 1 October 2020.
- Discussions included the closure and reopening of places of worship, including Catholic churches.
- The Right Reverend Peter Brignall (Bishop of Wrexham) and The Most Reverend Mark O'Toole did not attend the Forum within the specified timeframe.
