Thank you for your request for information dated the 3rd of January.

Information requested

You asked us:

- To explain the rationale for selecting Syr David's Avenue as the location for a cycle hangar, including how the site was chosen and whether any consultation informed this decision. You also requested evidence of any consultation carried out on our street, as referenced in a WalesOnline article.
- To confirm whether parking stress surveys, parking capacity assessments, or displacement analyses have been undertaken.
- To outline what consideration has been given to the impact on the resident-specific disabled parking bay.
- To clarify whether an Equality Impact Assessment or screening has been completed.
- To identify what alternative locations were evaluated and the reasons they were ruled out.
- To set out how environmental priorities were assessed, including the decision not to proceed with street tree replanting on Syr David's Avenue.
