

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A470
(PONTDOLGOCH, POWYS) (GWAHARDD
CERBYDAU DROS DRO) 2026**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A470, neu gerllaw iddi, ym Mhontdolgoch, Powys.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys, ar gyfer y gwaith neu gerbydau gwasanaeth cynnal a chadw y gaeaf, rhag mynd ar y darn o'r gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â'r B4568 hyd at y gilfan y tu allan i'r eiddo o'r enw 'Maesgwyn' (tua 570 o fetrau i'r gogledd-orllewin o bont reilffordd Pontdolgoch).

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r gogledd-orllewin fydd mynd ar yr A470 tua'r de-ddwyrain i Gaersŵs, yr A489 tua'r dwyrain i'r Drenewydd, yr A483 Ffordd Osgoi'r Drenewydd tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain hyd at Gylchfan Gorsaf y Trallwng, Smithfield Road, Mill Lane a'r B4381 tua'r gorllewin i Gylchfan Raven, yr A458 tua'r gorllewin i Fallwyd a'r A470 tua'r de i Lantwymyn: i'r gwrthwyneb ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r de-ddwyrain.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 12 Ionawr 2026. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol dros nos (19:00 – 06:00 o'r gloch) o 12 – 14 Ionawr 2026, neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A470 TRUNK ROAD (PONTDOLGOCH,
POWYS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
VEHICLES) ORDER 2026**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A470 trunk road at Pontdolgoch, Powys.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services, for the works or winter maintenance service vehicles, from proceeding on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the B4568 to the lay-by outside the property called 'Maesgwyn' (approximately 570 metres north-west of Pontdolgoch railway bridge).

The alternative route for north-westbound vehicles is via the south-eastbound A470 to Caersŵs, eastbound A489 to Newtown, north-eastbound A483 Newtown Bypass to Welshpool Station Roundabout, westbound Smithfield Road, Mill Lane and B4381 to Raven Roundabout, westbound A458 to Mallwyd and southbound A470 to Cemmaes Road: vice versa for south-eastbound vehicles.

The Order comes into force on 12 January 2026. The temporary prohibition is expected to operate overnight (19:00 – 06:00 hours) from 12 – 14 January 2026, or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the period specified above, it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.
