Is your business involved in delivering a housing scheme in the Carmarthenshire, Neath Port Talbot, Pembrokeshire or Swansea areas?

Some housing schemes have been stalled as Local Authorities work with Natural Resources Wales to meet the requirements of marine nitrates planning guidance.

Please read on if you think your business might be affected to find out what you can do.
Recommended actions are:

- Engage your appointed accountants/financial advisors to assess the impact of any delays.
- Maintain regular communications with your supply chain partners.
- Review your [sell2wales](#) profile to ensure notification of other upcoming contracts, including contract award notices which may offer potential business opportunities.
- Explore the [Wales Infrastructure Investment Strategy](#) to identify other planned programmes of work for which you may be able to compete.
- Engage with Local Economic Development Teams to explore available local support options (see below for contact information).
