**Statutory Register of Historic Parks & Gardens in Wales: Buckland House**

Dear [Regulation 13 Personal Data],

I am pleased to inform you that, following a review of existing entries and consultation with owners, the Register of Historic Parks and Gardens in Wales became statutory on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2022. Thank you for taking part in the consultation.

While the Historic Environment (Wales) Act 2016 placed a duty on the Welsh Ministers to compile and maintain a statutory register of historic parks and gardens in Wales, it did not introduce any new legal restrictions or a new consent regime. Registered sites and their settings will continue to receive the current level of protection through the planning system.

Full details of all registered historic parks and gardens are now available on Cof Cymru, Cadw's online resource of designated and registered historic assets in Wales — <https://cadw.gov.wales/advice-support/cof-cymru/search-cadw-records>. However, for your reference, I enclose the entry in the statutory register.
