

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A477
(SANCLÊR, SIR GAERFYRDDIN I DDOC
PENFRO, SIR BENFRO) (CYFYNGIADAU
CYFLYMDER DROS DRO A DIM
GODDIWEDDYD) 2026**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A477, neu gerllaw iddi, rhwng Sanclêr, Sir Gaerfyrddin a Doc Penfro, Sir Benfro.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gosod terfyn cyflymder o naill ai 40 mya neu 10 mya a gwahardd goddiweddyd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A477 sy'n ymestyn o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Sanclêr hyd at ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Waterloo, Doc Penfro, gan gynnwys system gylchu'r gylchfan honno. Disgwylir i'r terfyn cyflymder o 10 mya fod yn gymwys yn ystod gwaith confoi.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 3 Chwefror 2026. Disgwylir y bydd y cyfyngiadau a'r gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 00:01 o'r gloch ar 3 Chwefror 2026 am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf. Bydd hysbysiad o'r holl gyfnodau gwaith yn ystod y cyfnod hwn yn cael ei arddangos cyn iddynt ddechrau.

**THE A477 TRUNK ROAD (ST CLEARS,
CARMARTHENSHIRE TO PEMBROKE DOCK,
PEMBROKESHIRE) (TEMPORARY SPEED
RESTRICTIONS & NO OVERTAKING) ORDER
2026**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A477 trunk road between St Clears, Carmarthenshire and Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily impose either a 40 mph or 10 mph speed limit and prohibit overtaking on the length of the A477 trunk road that extends from the centre-point of its junction with St Clears Roundabout to its junction with, and including the gyratory of, Waterloo Roundabout, Pembroke Dock. The 10 mph speed limit is expected to apply during convoy working.

The Order comes into force on 3 February 2026. The temporary restrictions and prohibition are expected to operate intermittently from 00:01 hours on 3 February 2026 for a maximum duration of 18 months. Notice of all work periods during this time will be displayed prior to their commencement.
