ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROADS (A44/A470) (LLANGURIG BYPASS, POWYS)
(DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1991

MADE	19 th MARCH	1991
COMING INTO FORCE	1 st APRIL	1991

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Constabulary hereby Orders and directs as follows:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 1st APRIL 1991 and may be cited as the Trunk Roads (A44/A470) (Llangurig Bypass, Powys) (De-Restriction) Order 1991.
2. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Act of 1984.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Newtown-Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A44) at Llangurig in the County of Powys which extends from the centre point of the new A44/A470 roundabout to a point 280 metres north west of the centre point; a distance of 280 metres.

That length of the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) at Llangurig in the County of Powys which extends from a point 94 metres south west of the centre point of the new A44/A470 roundabout to a point 124 metres north east of that centre point; a distance of 218 metres.
