Complaint in respect of ATISN 26783 Godre'r Graig School

Thank you for your email which was received on 10th April 2026. As set out in my email to you on 13th April your complaint was referred to me for an internal review. I have now undertaken the review and write with the outcome.

Following the response dated 2nd April 2026 to your original Freedom of Information request (**ATISN 26783 - Information Request Godre'r Graig School, Godre'r Graig Tip and documents associated with the NPS Frameworks for South and West Wales regions**) you asked that Welsh Government check our records in relation to the 2017 NPS Framework and confirm whether records in relation to Godre'r Graig School and coal tip are held.

Further enquiries have been made across several teams within Welsh Government including the Commercial Procurement division. I have not identified any recorded information relating to the framework agreements outlined above concerning Godre'r Graig School or tip sites.

A number of the tender documents relating to the Framework more generally have been identified and I attach these to my response. These include the Invitation to Tender documents and the Schedules, the Technical response template and a worked example of the framework evaluation.
