**DATGANIAD O'R RHESYMAU**

Yn ddiweddar, mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi cwblhau gwaith i sicrhau bod tua 5 cilometr o'r hen ffordd ddeuol breifat, a elwir Ffordd Fynediad Gwaith Dur yr A4810 (Queen's Way) sy'n rhedeg drwy safle Tata Steel yn Llan-wern yng Nghasnewydd, yn cyrraedd safon priffordd gyhoeddus.

Bydd y cynllun uwchraddio yn gwella'r mynediad i Ardal Ehangu Dwyrain Casnewydd, gan gynnwys safle Datblygiad Glan Llyn, yn ogystal â darparu llwybr arall i draffordd yr M4 ac oddi yno. Bydd y ffordd hefyd yn darparu mynedfa newydd i dde a dwyrain Casnewydd o'r M4 i'r dwyrain o Gyffordd 23A ac yn atgyfnerthu rôl y Ffordd Ddosbarthu Ddeheuol fel llwybr arall o'r dwyrain i'r gorllewin o amgylch Casnewydd.

Ystyrir bod y Gorchymyn arfaethedig yn angenrheidiol er mwyn rheoleiddio cyflymder traffig ar hyd y ffordd ddeuol i hwyluso diogelwch ei defnyddwyr. Mae'r ffordd yn gwasanaethu traffig trwodd a busnesau.

Bydd terfynau cyflymder 30, 40 a 50 mya ar ddarnau cysylltiedig amrywiol o Ffordd Fynediad Gwaith Dur yr A4810 o ochr ddwyreiniol cylchfan yr A4810 â Baldwin Drive hyd at bwynt 50 metr i'r gorllewin o ganol Cyffordd Comin Broad Street, sef cyfanswm pellter o 5 cilometr.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The Welsh Ministers have recently completed work to bring up to public highway standard approximately 5km of the former private dual carriageway, known as the A4810 Steelworks Access Road (Queen's Way) running through the Tata Steel site at Llanwern in Newport.

The upgrading scheme will improve access to Newport's Eastern Expansion Area, including the Glan Llyn Development site as well as providing an alternative route from and to the M4 motorway. The road will also provide a new means of access to south and east Newport from the M4 east of Junction 23A and reinforce the role of the Southern Distributor Road as an alternative east-west route around Newport.

The proposed Order is considered necessary to regulate traffic speed along the dual carriageway to facilitate the safety of its users. The road serves both through traffic and businesses.

The speed limits will comprise 30, 40 and 50 mph speed limits over various connected lengths of the A4810 Steelworks Access Road from the eastern side of the A4810 roundabout with Baldwin Drive to a point 50 metres west of the centre of the Broad Street Common Junction, a total distance of 5 kilometres.
