For your info, we have received a report of a possible leopard sighting.

The complainant initially phoned DPP at 0352am, 16/01/2023. [REDACTED]  
She stated that she let her dog out in her garden and saw a leopard with spots walking around her garden.

She stated that the dog didn't react and that her security lights kept coming on as it was walking around.

The complainant then phoned DPP again at 0403am, 16/01/2023. [REDACTED]  
She stated that the leopard was standing on her windowsill outside and that the lights were on. Whilst the operator spoke to the complainant it was suggested that she obtained a photograph. The complainant stated that the animal was a fair size and that her dog was back inside. Our message was endorsed that there was no CCTV at the complainants address.
