Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 8 June 2026. You asked for:

1. Insurance Requirements - The minimum levels of indemnity insurance (including but not limited to Public Liability, Employers' Liability, and Professional Indemnity) required as part of the tender. - Confirmation of whether the successful suppliers met these minimum insurance requirements at the point of submission.
2. Cyber Security Requirements - Details of the cyber security requirements specified within the tender (e.g. Cyber Essentials, Cyber Essentials Plus, ISO 27001, or equivalent). - Confirmation of whether the successful suppliers held the required cyber security certification at the time of tender submission.
3. Compliance Verification - Confirmation of whether any clarifications were issued to bidders in relation to insurance or cyber security requirements. - Confirmation of whether any bidders were deemed non-compliant or excluded due to failure to meet these requirements.

Our response

1. Minimum levels of indemnity insurance were set as follows:

- Employers Liability - £5,000,000
- Public and Products Liability - £5,000,000

Both successful suppliers provided evidence that they met these requirements at point of submission.

2. The requirement was the standard Cyber Essentials certification. Both successful suppliers held the required certification at the time of tender submission.
3. No clarifications were issued to bidders in relation to insurance or cyber security requirements. No bidders were excluded from the tender process as a result of failure to meet the minimum insurance or cyber security requirements.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
