THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF RHONDDA CYNON TAFF: LIST NO. 28: THE COMMUNITY OF HIRWAUN AS AT 06/08/2002

1. Under section 1 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, the National Assembly for Wales is required to compile lists of buildings which appear to be of special architectural or historic interest.

2. Following consultation with persons or bodies of persons who appear appropriate as having knowledge of, and interest in, such buildings, the Welsh Assembly Government has concluded that the buildings described in the attached Schedule are buildings of special architectural or historic interest.

NODIADAU ESBONIADOL

1. Mae'r wybodaeth a roddwyd yn yr Atodiad hwn ar y cyfan yn hunanesboniadol, ond dylid nodi'r pwyntiau canlynol:

a. Mae'r rhestr hon yn gronnol, ac yn cofnodi adeiladau sydd wedi eu cynnwys mewn rhestrau blaenorol a luniwyd o dan Ddeddfau Cynllunio Gwlad a Thref 1947-1971 a Deddf Cynllunio (Adeiladau Rhestredig ac Ardaloedd Cadwraeth) 1990 ar gyfer yr ardal dan sylw, yn ychwanegol at adeiladau a restrir nawr am y tro cyntaf. Caiff yr adeiladau a restrwyd o'r blaen eu dangos gyda dau ddyddiad; mae'r dyddiad cyntaf "*Y Dyddiad Rhestru*" yn cofnodi'r dyddiad y cafodd yr adeilad ei gynnwys gyntaf mewn rhestr o adeiladau o ddiddordeb pensaernïol neu hanesyddol arbennig. Mae'r ail ddyddiad "*Y Dyddiad Diwygio*" yn cofnodi'r dyddiad y daeth y rhestr bresennol i rym. Dangosir yr adeiladau a restrir am y tro cyntaf gyda dim ond un dyddiad yn unig sef "*Y Dyddiad Rhestru*".

b. Nid oes gan y nodiadau disgrifiadol a gynhwysir ym mhob cofnod unrhyw arwyddocâd cyfreithiol ac fe'u bwriedir yn bennaf at ddibenion adnabod. Ni ddylid eu trin fel cofnod cynhwysfawr neu eithriadol o'r holl nodweddion y credir sy'n gwneud adeilad yn un teilwng o gael ei restru.

2. Yn yr Atodiad, defnyddir y talfyriadau canlynol:-

"Rhif Cofnod"

Rhif adnabod unigryw yw hwn ar gyfer p adeilad rhestredig yng Nghymru. Fe'i gysy â chronfa ddata gyfrifiadurol o bob adei rhestredig yng Nghymru a dylid ei ddyfynu b tro y byddwch yn delio â CADW a'r awdurd cynllunio lleol.

"Cyf Grid"

Dyma'r Rhif Cyfeirnod y Grid Cenedlaethol. Er y caiff ei roi mor gywir â phosibl, ni fydd unrhyw gamgymeriad yn y ffigwr hwn yn effeithio ar ddilysrwydd unrhyw restru.

"C"

Canrif. e.e C18 = Y Ddeunawfed Ganrif

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The information given in this Schedule is on the whole self explanatory, but the following points should be noted:

a. This list is cumulative, and records buildings included in previous lists compiled under the Town and Country Planning Acts 1947-1971 and Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 for the area in question, in addition to buildings now listed for the first time. Buildings previously listed are shown with two dates; the first date "*Date Listed*" records the date the building was first included in a list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest, the second date "*Date Amended*" records the date the present list took effect. Buildings listed for the first time are shown with only one date "*Date Listed*".

b. The descriptive notes included in each entry have no legal significance and are intended primarily for identification purposes. They should not be treated as a comprehensive or exclusive record of all the features which are considered to make a building worthy of listing.

2. In the Schedule, the following abbreviations are used:-

"Record No"

This is a unique identifying number for every listed building in Wales. It is linked to a computerised database of all Welsh listed buildings and should be quoted in all dealings with CADW and the local planning authority

"Grid Ref"

This is the National Grid Reference Number. Although this is given as accurately as possible, any mistake in this figure does not affect the validity of any listing.

"C"

Century. e.g. C18 = Eighteenth Century

Location

Set back from and placed at an angle to the road near the W end of Swansea Road, and E of Millstreet Bridge.

History

An early C19 house shown on the 1840 Tithe map, which may therefore have been occupied by a clerk or manager at Hirwaun Ironworks.

Exterior

A Georgian house of 2 storeys with attic and basement, of limewashed rubble-stone 3-window front, roof replaced with synthetic slates, and rendered end stacks. Openings are offset to the R and have cambered heads. Most of the windows in the front elevation are renewed small-pane sashes in original openings. The central round-headed doorway has a panelled door and replaced plain overlight. In the lower storey the windows are irregularly placed to the R and L of the doorway, while immediately L of the doorway is a blocked former window (only visible inside the house). The upper storey has 3 regularly placed and smaller windows. The basement, occupying the L side of the house, has an original 12-pane hornless sash window to the L, and a boarded door to the R with a small inserted fixed light to its R. The L gable end is rendered. The rubble-stone rear has a single-storey outshut with basement, which has been raised to 2 storeys under a pitched roof on the L side. Windows are replaced but a 2-light C19 casement window is retained to the basement on the R side, while a replaced door is to the L side.

In front of the centre and R side of the house is a forecourt. Its gateway has square freestone piers with pyramid caps (gates are missing), to the R of which is a dwarf wall with iron railings, terminating with a pier similar to the gate piers.

Interior

Openings are blocked that formerly provided internal access to No 45. A single slate chimneypiece has survived in the lower storey. In the upper storey is a fragment of a former stone winding attic stair. The lower storey retains panelled doors, the upper storey boarded doors.

Listed

Listed as a rare well-preserved early C19 town house retaining original character.
