On the eastern edge of the town at a splayed angle to the road. Set back on the corner beyond the bridge over the River Cynon; detached to left and with railed forecourt walls to right with pyramidal capped gate posts.

Early to mid C19. Shown on 1877 OS map as 2 properties. Two-storey 3-bay whitewashed rubble front with basement to left. Slate roof and roughcast chimney stack. Mostly camber headed sash windows with brick roussoirs. 12-pane to 1st floor and basement and 16-pane to ground floor. Most openings are offset to the right. The ground floor right window is placed close to the semicircular leaded main entrance with 6-panel door and plain fanlight. Square leaded basement window and boarded door, formerly the entrance to the left hand property. The steps down to the basement also give access to a door into a cellar below the forecourt. Catslide roof to rear and some modern openings. 1877 OS map shows a row of small cottages extending back from the left hand property.

A specially well preserved 'valleys' town house which possibly originally had a industrial association - the right hand part may have been the factory manager's house and the left hand part, the top house in the terrace at right angles.
