Thank you for your request to Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 30 June 2026 relating to the service known as Tîm Emrallt, or any Problematic and Harmful Sexual Behaviour (PHSB) service operating within North Wales. You requested the following information:

- 1. Any reports, briefing papers, assessments, reviews, or correspondence referring to Tîm Emrallt, or a Problematic and Harmful Sexual Behaviour (PHSB) service within North Wales.*
- 2. Any recorded information referring to the governance, accountability, oversight, performance, or effectiveness of Tîm Emrallt.*
- 3. Any correspondence or reports exchanged between the National Independent Safeguarding Board and the North Wales Safeguarding Board in which Tîm Emrallt, or a Problematic and Harmful Sexual Behaviour (PHSB) service, is discussed.*
- 4. Any records identifying whether Tîm Emrallt has formed part of any national review, assurance process, thematic review, inspection support, or evaluation undertaken or commissioned by the National Independent Safeguarding Board.*
- 5. Any recorded information identifying which organisation has responsibility for the governance or accountability of Tîm Emrallt, if such information is held.*

This includes, but is not limited to:

- reports;*
- meeting papers;*
- agendas and minutes;*
- briefing notes;*
- correspondence;*
- presentations;*
- assurance documents;*
- review documents; and*
- electronic records.*
