Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A4076 (Aberdaugleddau, Sir Benfro) (Gwahardd Cerbydau Dros Dro) 2026

Gwnaed 25 Mehefin 2026
Yn dod i rym 4 Gorffennaf 2026

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod traffig ar gyfer cefnffordd yr A4076, wedi eu bodloni y dylid gwahardd traffig ar ddarn penodedig o'r gefnffordd oherwydd bod digwyddiad perthnasol, sef Carnifal Aberdaugleddau, yn cael ei gynnal ar y ffordd neu gerllaw iddi.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, felly, drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir iddynt gan adran 16A o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(1), yn gwneud y Gorchymyn hwn.

Enwi a chychwyn

1. Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A4076 (Aberdaugleddau, Sir Benfro) (Gwahardd Cerbydau Dros Dro) 2026 a daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 4 Gorffennaf 2026.

Dehongli

2. Yn y Gorchymyn hwn—
- ystyr “cerbyd esempt” (“*exempted vehicle*”) yw—
- (i) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at ddibenion yr heddlu, y gwasanaeth tân neu'r gwasanaeth ambiwlans;

ROAD TRAFFIC

The A4076 Trunk Road (Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2026

Made 25 June 2026
Coming into force 4 July 2026

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A4076 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of a relevant event, namely the Milford Haven Carnival, being held on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A4076 Trunk Road (Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2026 and this Order comes into force on 4 July 2026.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—
- “event period” (“*cyfnod y digwyddiad*”) means that period commencing at 12:45 hours on 4 July 2026 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672 and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

- (ii) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio mewn cysylltiad â gwaith ar y ffordd neu oleuadau neu arwyddion traffig neu waith brys i unrhyw garthffos neu i unrhyw brif bibell neu gyfarpar ar gyfer cyflenwi nwy, dŵr neu drydan, neu gyfarpar telathrebu yn y darn o'r ffordd o dan sylw, neu mewn unrhyw dir cyfagos;
- (iii) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio gan un o swyddogion awdurdodedig y digwyddiad i gefnogi'r digwyddiad ac am resymau diogelwch;

ystyr "cyfnod y digwyddiad" ("*event period*") yw'r cyfnod sy'n dechrau am 12:45 o'r gloch ar 4 Gorffennaf 2026 ac sy'n dod i ben pan gaiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith;

ystyr "y gefnffordd" ("*the trunk road*") yw cefnffordd yr A4076 Hwlffordd i Aberdaugleddau.

Gwaharddiad

3. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y digwyddiad, yrru unrhyw gerbyd, ac eithrio cerbyd esempt, ar y darn o'r gefnffordd a elwir yn Victoria Road, Hamilton Terrace a Great North Road yn Aberdaugleddau, Sir Benfro sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â St Anne's Road hyd at ei chyffordd â Charles Street.

Cymhwyso

4. Nid yw'r gwaharddiad yn erthygl 3 yn gymwys ond ar yr adegau hynny ac i'r graddau hynny y bydd arwyddion traffig yn eu dangos.

Cyfnod para'r Gorchymyn hwn

5. Bydd y Gorchymyn hwn yn para am 1 diwrnod ar y mwyaf.

Llofnodwyd ar ran y Dirprwy Weinidog Trafnidiaeth, yn gweithredu o dan awdurdod y Gweinidog Cabinet dros Fenter, Cysylltedd ac Ynni, un o Weinidogion Cymru.

"exempted vehicle" ("*cerbyd esempt*") means—

- (i) any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance services purposes;
- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned;
- (iii) any vehicle used by an authorised event official in support of and for reasons of the safety of the event;

"the trunk road" ("*y gefnffordd*") means the A4076 Haverfordwest to Milford Haven trunk road.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the event period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as Victoria Road, Hamilton Terrace and Great North Road at Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire that extends from its junction with St Anne's Road to its junction with Charles Street.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 1 day.
