

**GORCHYMYN TRAFFORDD YR M4 A
CHEFNFFORDD YR A470 (CYFNEWIDFA
CORYTON, CAERDYDD I GYLCHFAN CEFN
COED, MERTHYR TUDFUL) (GWAHARDD
CERBYDAU A BEICWYR DROS DRO) 2026**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar draffordd yr M4 a chefnffordd yr A470, neu gerllaw iddynt, rhwng Cyfnewidfa Coryton, Caerdydd a Chylchfan Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tudful.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd (ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys neu ar gyfer y gwaith) a beicwyr rhag mynd ar y darnau o draffordd yr M4, ac ar hyd ddarnau penodol o gefnffordd yr A470 pan fo'n ofynnol gwneud gwaith ar safleoedd penodol, rhwng Gylchfan Coryton a Chylchfan Cefn Coed, fel y'u disgrifir yn yr Atodlen i'r Hysbysiad hwn. Disgrifir y llwybrau eraill yn yr Atodlen honno hefyd.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 1 Gorffennaf 2026. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiadau dros dro yn weithredol yn ysbeidiol dros nos (20:00 – 06:00 o'r gloch) o'r dyddiad hwnnw am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf. Arddangosir hysbysiad ynghylch y gwaharddiadau tuag un wythnos cyn bod angen cau darn penodol o'r ffordd.

Y darnau o ffyrdd ymadael neilltuedig tua'r dwyrain a thua'r gorllewin yr M4 wrth Gyffordd 32 (Coryton), sy'n arwain at yr A470 tua'r gogledd.

**THE M4 MOTORWAY & A470 TRUNK ROAD
(CORYTON INTERCHANGE, CARDIFF TO
CEFN COED ROUNDABOUT, MERTHYR
TYDFIL) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
VEHICLES & CYCLISTS) ORDER 2026**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is necessary to undertake works on or near the M4 motorway & A470 trunk road between Coryton Interchange, Cardiff and Cefn Coed Roundabout, Merthyr Tydfil.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles (other than those being used by the emergency services and for the works) and cyclists from proceeding on the lengths of the M4 motorway, and over specific lengths of the A470 trunk road when work at a particular site is required, between Coryton Roundabout and Cefn Coed Roundabout as described in the Schedule to this Notice. The alternative route arrangements are also described therein.

The Order comes into force on 1 July 2026. The temporary prohibitions are expected to operate intermittently overnight (20:00 – 06:00 hours) from that date for a maximum duration of 18 months. Notice of the prohibitions will be displayed approximately one week before the closure of a particular length of road.

SCHEDULE

The lengths of the M4 eastbound and westbound dedicated exit slip lanes at Junction 32 (Coryton), leading to the northbound A470.

Y darn o gefnffordd yr A470, gan gynnwys yr holl ffyrdd ymuno ac ymadael o Gyfnewidfa Coryton, Caerdydd i Gylchfan Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tudful.

Ffordd gyswllt neilltuedig yr A470 o'i chyffordd â phrif gerbyttffordd gylchredol Cyfnewidfa Coryton i'w chyffordd â phrif gerbyttffordd tua'r de cefnffordd yr A470.

Llwybrau eraill

Codir arwyddion priodol i nodi'r gwyriad ar gyfer y llwybrau eraill a byddant yn amrywio gan ddibynnu ar ben y daith a phryd y bydd darn penodol o'r M4 a'r A470 a ddisgrifir uchod ar gau dros dro i draffig.

Mae llwybrau eraill ar gael drwy fynd ar yr A4054, A473, A472, A465, A468, A4060, A470, A4058 a'r B4275, fel y bo'n briodol.

The length of the A470 trunk road, including all entry and exit slip roads from Coryton Interchange, Cardiff to Cefn Coed Roundabout, Merthyr Tydfil.

The dedicated A470 link road from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Coryton Interchange to its junction with the main southbound carriageway of the A470 trunk road.

Alternative routes

The alternative routes will be signed with appropriate diversion signs and will vary depending on destination and when a particular length of the M4 and A470 within the above description is temporarily closed to traffic.

Alternative routes are available via the A4054, A473, A472, A465, A468, A4060, A470, A4058 and B4275, as appropriate.
