Hi Information redacted,

As requested, and briefly discussed on teams, please find the details below.

- a) The width of the stone gatepost – The stone gate post measures 150mm wide and 550mm deep when viewed from the carriageway.
- b) Its offset from the edge of carriageway of the A487 – Roadside face of stone post to roadside edge of kerb/gully is 1080mm.
- c) It's placement relative to a nearby fixed object, if possible, i.e. gully – Southern face of stone post to northern edge of nearby gully is 530mm.

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Also, for info, the southern edge of Water Street to the northern face of the stone post is approx. 121m.

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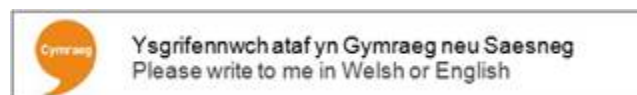

We have just been contacted by the applicant's agent with updated scheme drawings to reflect amended visibility splay lines that apparently reflect that which is achievable on

site. They are now stating that from a setback of 2.4m, a visibility splay of 100m is achievable.

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As can be seen, when compared against the submitted scheme drawing, the existing stone gatepost within the supplied photo appears to be closer to the edge of carriageway of the A487 than that depicted within the topographical survey upon which the approved (and subsequent) visibility splay drawing has been produced.

Clearly, such an obstruction being much closer to the trunk road would significantly impact the maximum achievable visibility splay.

I would be grateful if you might be able to arrange a visit to the site to obtain a measurement to determine the following please:

- a) The width of the stone gatepost
- b) Its offset from the edge of carriageway of the A487
- c) It's placement relative to a nearby fixed object, if possible, i.e. gully

Dwg: 2616-200 Proposed Highway Works – A1 Size (Original scheme drawing) shows the original, as approved vis splay based on 120m being achievable from a set-back of 2.5m – passing through and beyond the location of the stone gatepost (represented as a rectangular symbol).

Dwg: 2616-200 Rev B Proposed Highway Works – A1 Size (Latest revision)

This now shows the visibility splay passing in front of the stone gatepost symbol, with a stated, achievable visibility splay of 100m from a set-back of 2.4m.
