Freedom of Information Request: ATISN 27299

Thank you for your further email of 12 August where you asked:

- 1) whether the Welsh Government can identify the relevant road section from the description "Newtown Bypass Western Section" and the site / image overlay code 74023004.
- 2) Welsh Government holds no record mapping enforcement site / image overlay code 74023004 to any trunk-road location, chainage, GIS point or road-section reference;
- 3) Welsh Government does not hold that mapping, but believes it is held by another body, in which case please identify the body, team or office likely to hold it;
- 4) Welsh Government requires a further specific location marker, in which case please identify precisely what marker is required and why the existing description and site / image overlay code are insufficient.

Our Response

- 1) No the Welsh Government cannot identify the relevant road section from your description
- 2) Welsh Government hold no information mapping enforcement site / image overlay code 74023004
- 3) Welsh Government does not hold the mapping – it may be held by GoSafe or Dyfed Powys Police
- 4) As advised in the previous clarification letter Welsh Government are not the enforcement body so the site image overlay code 74023004 is not known to us.

I previously suggested easy ways for you to identify the location to me (I made the assumption you know whereabouts on the Western section of the Newtown Bypass you require the information for) but if you wish to provide marker posts, map references or GIS identifier then that would be acceptable. If that is not possible then I can still provide you with information relating to speed limits, chainage of speed restrictions and signage between the different roundabouts on the bypass e.g. Llanidloes Roundabout at the Western End of the bypass and the next roundabout, the Dolfor Roundabout. If that is acceptable, please let me know and I will treat it as a new Freedom of Information request.

Next Steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
