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

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
CAR OR VAN AVAILABILITY IN WALES

Introduction


This bulletin brings together the information from the 2001 Census of Population on car or van availability in Wales. It is displayed as a series of charts, bullet points and tables. Some data are displayed at unitary authority level, but where individual cell counts are too small, the data are shown at an all-Wales level.




- ◆ 74 per cent of households in Wales had access to at least one car or van in 2001.
- ♦ 26 per cent of households in Wales had no access to a car or van in 2001, 46 per cent had access to one car or van and 29 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ◆ The proportion of households with access to at least one car or van ranged from 65 per cent in Merthyr Tydfil and Blaenau Gwent to 83 per cent in Powys and Monmouthshire.
- ◆ Monmouthshire had the highest proportion of households with access to at least two cars or vans (40 per cent), whilst Blaenau Gwent and Merthyr Tydfil both had the lowest proportions (20 per cent).




◆ People who were self-employed, employees or economically active full-time students were more likely to live in households with access to at least one car or van (97 per cent, 91 per cent and 87 per cent respectively) than people who were unemployed or economically inactive (68 and 75 per cent respectively).





◆ Households where the household reference person was from the Indian or Chinese ethnic groups were more likely than other households to have access to at least one car or van (82 per cent and 80 per cent respectively).




- ♦ 68 per cent of people in Wales with a limiting long-term illness live in households with access to at least one car or van.
- ◆ The proportion of people with a limiting long-term illness living in households with access to at least one car or van ranged from 61 per cent in Cardiff and Newport to 77 per cent in Ceredigion and Powys.













- ♦ 52 per cent of households with one person aged 17 or over had no access to a car or van, 45 per cent had access to one car or van, and 3 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ♦ 13 per cent of households with two people aged 17 or over had no access to a car or van, 51 per cent had access to one car or van, and 37 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ♦ 9 per cent of households with three people aged 17 or over had no access to a car or van, 34 per cent had access to one car or van, and 58 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ♦ 8 per cent of households with four or more people aged 17 or over had no access to a car or van, 23 per cent had access to one car or van, and 69 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.









- ♦ 26 per cent of all households in Wales had no access to a car or van, 46 per cent had access to one car or van, and 29 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ♦ 48 per cent of pensioner households in Wales had no access to a car or van, 46 per cent had access to one car or van, and 6 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ♦ 17 per cent of households in Wales with dependent children had no access to a car or van, 43 per cent had access to one car or van, and 40 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
- ◆ 48 per cent of lone parent households in Wales with dependent children had no access to a car or van, 47 per cent had one available car or van, and 6 per cent had access to at least two cars or vans.
