1. Cyflwyniad a methodoleg

1.1 Cefndir

1.1.1 Arolwg parhaus sy'n cynnwys hyd at 12,000 o ymatebwyr 16 oed a throsodd wedi eu dewis ar hap a gynhelir ledled Cymru bob blwyddyn yw Arolwg Cenedlaethol Cymru. Mae'r arolwg yn cwmpasu ystod eang o destunau gan gynnwys gwasanaethau cyhoeddus, cyflogaeth, gofal plant, y Gymraeg, a gwasanaethau iechyd a gofal cymdeithasol. Fe adolygir y testunau bob blwyddyn i sicrhau bod yr arolwg yn dal i ddiwallu anghenion defnyddwyr yr arolwg.

1.1.2 O ganlyniad i bandemig y coronafeirws (COVID-19), mae'r Arolwg Cenedlaethol wedi bod trwy newidiadau sylweddol ers 2020, gan newid o arolwg wyneb-yn-wyneb i arolwg dros y ffôn yn ystod y cyfnod hwn. Ers 2022-23, mae'r arolwg hefyd wedi cynnwys adran ddilynol sy'n cael ei hunangwblhau ar-lein. O 2024-25, fe ychwanegwyd yr opsiwn ar gyfer arolwg wyneb-yn-wyneb a arweinir gan gyfwelydd (CAPI), gan gynnwys adran hunangwblhau ar lechen (CASI).

1.1.3 Nod y prosiect ymchwil hwn oedd cynnal profion gwybyddol ar ystod o gwestiynau newydd a ddatblygwyd ar gyfer Arolwg Cenedlaethol 2024-25. Mae profion gwybyddol yn archwilio sut y mae cyfranogwyr yn deall, yn prosesu, ac yn ymateb i gwestiynau unigol yn yr arolwg, gyda gwaith gwybyddol 2024-25 yn cwmpasu cymysgedd o gwestiynau a oedd yn bodoli eisoes a chwestiynau newydd nad oeddent wedi cael eu profi o'r blaen. Mae'n bwysig profi cwestiynau'r arolwg i sicrhau bod ymatebwyr yn deall cysyniadau neu dasgau'r cwestiynau yn y ffordd y mae'r ymchwilwyr yn ei bwriadu, eu bod yn eu deall mewn modd cyson, a'u bod yn fodlon ac yn gallu darparu atebion. Mae hyn yn helpu i sicrhau bod canlyniadau'r arolwg yn ddibynadwy, yn ddilys ac yn ddiduedd.

1.2 Methodoleg – adolygiad desg

1.2.1 Cyn y profion gwybyddol, cynhaliwyd adolygiad trylwyr o'r cwestiynau newydd arfaethedig gan ddefnyddio Fframwaith Arfarnu Cwestiynau (QAF) Kantar Public. Addaswyd hwn o [QAS-99](#) i ganolbwytio'n fwy eglur ar faterion sy'n effeithio ar holiaduron ymchwil gymdeithasol. Mae'n darparu fframwaith systematig ar gyfer gwerthuso cwestiynau, gan alluogi'r defnyddiwr i adnabod a chywiro problemau posibl gyda chwestiynau a all arwain at anawsterau gyda gweinyddu cwestiynau, camgyfathrebu neu fethiannau eraill. Mae'r defnyddiwr yn archwilio cwestiynau trwy ystyried mein i prawf penodol (megis eglurder, tybiaethau, cyfarwyddiadau,

gwybodaeth/galw i gof, anhawster y dasg, sensitifrwydd a thuedd dymunoldeb cymdeithasol) ac yn penderfynu a yw'r cwestiwn yn arddangos nodweddion sy'n debygol o achosi problemau.

1.2.2 Darparwyd canfyddiadau o'r arolwg ar gyfer Llywodraeth Cymru, a'r rheiny'n cynnwys sylwadau ar bob cwestiwn gydag argymhellion ar gyfer unrhyw newidiadau i'r geiriad ar gyfer ar gyfer cylch cyntaf y profion gwybyddol. Bwydodd canfyddiadau'r adolygiad hwn i mewn i ddatblygiad cwestiynau profi gwybyddol, i sicrhau bod materion allweddol yn cael eu profi'n ddigon manwl.

1.3 Methodoleg – profion gwybyddol

1.3.1 Cynhaliwyd cyfanswm o 22 o gyfweliadau yn y cnawd dros ddau gylch gan dri ymchwilydd ar ran Kantar Public, gydag ymatebwyr ag ystod o nodweddion gwahanol. Fe gyfwelodd Kantar Public ag 11 o ddynion ac 11 o fenywod o oedrannau ac â chymwysterau addysgol amrywiol. Cynhaliwyd oddeutu hanner y cyfweliadau ym mhob cylch yng Nghaerdydd a'r hanner arall yn Wrecsam.

1.3.2 Nod y cylch profi cyntaf oedd adnabod unrhyw broblemau gyda'r cwestiynau trwy archwilio dealltwriaeth yr ymatebwyr am y cwestiynau a'r opsiynau ymateb. Fe wnaeth yr ail gylch brofi newidiadau a wnaed i gwestiynau y cafwyd eu bod yn broblemus yn y cylch cyntaf, gan hefyd ailbrofi nifer o gwestiynau a oedd heb newid ers Cylch 1 (i gasglu tystiolaeth ychwanegol ar strategaethau ateb a darparu sicrwydd pellach eu bod yn gweithio fel a ddisgwyliwyd). Hefyd, fe ychwanegwyd nifer o gwestiynau newydd (o ganlyniad i ganfyddiadau Cylch 1) yn yr adrannau canlynol:

- Chwaraeon Cymru – Hybu cyfranogiad
- Chwaraeon Cymru – Gwirfoddoli a hyfforddi
- Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru – Perygl llifogydd
- Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru – Mannau gwyrdd a naturiol
- Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru – Pryder a gweithredu amgylcheddol
- Ymwybyddiaeth o gynghorwyr lleol

1.3.3 Recriwtwyd y sampl gan asiantaeth bartner Kantar Public [Criteria Fieldwork](#), asiantaeth recriwtio ansoddol arbenigol. Fe wnaeth recriwtwyr sy'n arbenigo mewn

dod o hyd i ymatebwyr ymhliith y cyhoedd ddefnyddio dulliau amrywiol i recriwtio pobl ar gyfer y cwotâu a nodwyd. Roedd y rhain yn cynnwys: 'tyfu fel caseg eira' o ymatebwyr a oedd wedi gwneud ymchwil yn flaenorol trwy'r asiantaeth a/ neu asiantaethau partner, rhwydweithiau o fewn eu cymunedau sefydledig ac ymweld ag ardaloedd lleol i sefydlu cysylltiadau a rhwydweithiau newydd.

1.3.4 Mae Tabl 1.1 yn amlinellu testunau'r cwestiynau yr ymdriniwyd â hwy ar bob cam. Ni chafodd cwestiynau yn yr adran 'Chwaraeon Cymru – Gwylio' eu cario ymlaen i Gylch 1 gan yr ystyriwyd eu bod yn ddigon syml fel nad oedd angen eu profi. Ni chafodd y cwestiynau am 'Ymwybyddiaeth o gynghorwyr tref a chymuned' a 'Hyder yn y System Gyflawnder' eu dwyn ymlaen i Gylch 1 ychwaith. Fe adnabuwyd nifer o faterion gyda'r cwestiynau hyn ar adeg yr adolygiad desg, ac ystyriwyd fod y testun yn rhy gymhleth i ymdrin yn briodol ag ef yn yr arolwg ar y cam hwn.

2. Profion cylch un

2.1 Ar y cyfan, fe weithiodd y mwyafrif o'r cwestiynau a werthuswyd yng nghylch un yn dda, gydag ymatebwyr yn deall y cwestiynau'n ddidrafferth ac yn darparu ateb yn rhwydd. Gan hynny, roedd y mwyafrif o'r cwestiynau'n ddigfnewid wrth symud i mewn i'r ail gylch profi. Er enghraift, fe weithiodd y cwestiynau ar Hybu Cyfranogiad mewn Chwaraeon, Gweithredu Amgylcheddol, a Pheryglon Sŵn yn dda ac ni chynigiwyd rhyw lawer o newidiadau.

2.2 Fodd bynnag, cafodd rhai cwestiynau (ac, mewn rhai achosion, modiwlau cyfan) eu hadnabod fel rhai a oedd yn achosi pryder. Profodd y cwestiwn Chwaraeon Cymru am gyfleusterau chwaraeon yn broblemus oherwydd deongliadau anghyson – meddyliodd rhai ymatebwyr am nifer y cyfleusterau a oedd ar gael, tra bo eraill wedi meddwl am yr ystod o weithgareddau a oedd yn cael eu cynnig. Cododd problem ar wahân lle atebodd ymatebwyr mewn perthynas â defnyddio'r cyfleusterau hyn yn gyffredinol, yn hytrach na chanolbwytio dim ond ar eu defnydd hwy eu hunain. Roedd trafferthion gyda'r cwestiynau am Fioamrywiaeth hefyd. Tueddodd ymatebwyr i feddwl dim ond am eu hardal leol hwy eu hunain (yn hytrach na

Chymru gyfan, fel a gyfarwyddid yn nhestun y cwestiwn) ac fe gafodd rhai anhawster gwahaniaethu rhwng eu lefel pryder ynghylch bioamrywiaeth sy'n lleihau a chydubyddiaeth fwy sylfaenol ei fod yn digwydd.

2.3 Fe argymhellwyd newidiadau a gwelliannau i nifer o cwestiynau yn seiliedig ar y canfyddiadau ar gyfer y cwestiynau hyn. Fe wnaed nifer o ddiwygiadau yn seiliedig ar adborth o'r cylch profi cyntaf, e.e. cafodd geiriad rhai cwestiynau ac opsiynau ymateb ei newid ychydig bach; ac fe ychwanegwyd neu fe newidiwyd cyfarwyddiadau i gyfwelwyr ac enghreifftiau lle'r oedd ymatebwyr yn ansicr sut i ateb.

3. Profion cylch dau

3.1 Fe wnaeth yr ail gylch profi hi'n bosibl gwerthuso'r cwestiynau diwygiedig i benderfynu a oedd y newidiadau arfaethedig wedi helpu i leihau'r baich gwybyddol ar gyfer ymatebwyr, ac fe wnaethant hi'n bosibl i'r cwestiynau a oedd yn weddill gael eu profi gan gronfa ehangach o gyfranogwyr.

3.2 Cafodd y rhan fwyaf o'r cwestiynau diwygiedig eu deall yn dda gan yr ymatebwyr, a gwelwyd fod yr esboniadau a'r newidiadau a gymhwyswyd ar ôl y cylch profi cyntaf yn helpu dealltwriaeth gyffredinol cyfranogwyr.

3.3 Fodd bynnag, cafodd rhai problemau eu hadnabod o hyd:

- Chwaraeon Cymru Hybu cyfranogiad yn y dyfodol – ni weithiodd y cwestiwn a oedd yn holi am bethau a allai helpu ymatebwyr i gymryd rhan mewn mwy o chwaraeon neu weithgareddau corfforol (SportMore) yn dda. Fe achosodd y rhestr gynorthwyol o ymatebion i nifer o ymatebwyr ddewis atebion nad oeddent yn berthnasol iddynt mewn gwirionedd.
- Chwaraeon Cymru Cyfleusterau – Nid aeth y newidiadau a wnaed yn dilyn Cylch 1 i'r afael â'r materion a adnabuwyd. Fe wnaeth ymatebwyr nad oeddent wedi defnyddio cyfleusterau lleol ddal i gynnig barn (gan gytuno neu anghytuno) yn seiliedig ar faterion eraill, megis arsylwadau (e.e. cyfleusterau y maent wedi sylwi arnynt wrth yr yrru), gwybodaeth o'r cyfryngau lleol, neu ddyfalu yn seiliedig ar yr hyn allai fod ar bobl eraill ei eisiau neu ei angen yn eu tyb hwy.
- Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru Bioamrywiaeth – Cyflwynodd y cwestiynau hyn herwybyddol sylweddol i ymatebwyr, oherwydd dibyniaeth arnynt i fod yn meddu

ar beth gwybodaeth a dealltwriaeth am y cynnwys, nad oedd y rhan fwyaf o ymatebwyr yn meddu arnynt.

- Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru Mannau gwyrdd a naturiol – Roedd y modd y dehonglwyd cwestiynau am ansawdd mannau gwyrdd lleol yn amrywio. Roedd hi'n amlwg nad oedd rhai ymatebwyr yn deall yr hyn a ofynnid iddynt.

3.4 Mae Atodiad A yn crynhoi'r cwestiynau a brofwyd ym mhob cylch. Mae'r tabl cychwynnol ar gyfer pob testun (mewn glas) yn amlygu'r broses ailadroddol yr aeth pob un o gwestiynau'r arolwg drwyddi o'r geiriad gwreiddiol a werthuswyd yn ystod yr adolygiad desg, ac yn ystod y cylch cyntaf a'r ail gylch o brofion gwbyddol. Mewn rhai achosion roedd y geiriad yn ddifyfnewid, h.y. mae'r geiriad a ddefnyddiwyd yn yr adolygiad desg yn adlewyrchu'r geiriad terfynol a gynigiwyd, ond mewn eraill fe newidiodd y geiriad yn ystod un neu fwy nag un or camau yn y broses profi gwbyddol.

3.5 Mae'r ail dabl (mewn coch) yn dangos fersiwn derfynol y cwestiynau a gynigiwyd i Lywodraeth Cymru.
